First Destination Survey (FDS)

What is the FDS?

The First Destination Survey provides data on where Clarkson graduates land after college. Using standards outlined by the **National Association of Colleges and Employers**(NACE), The Career Center gathers this information annually, and provides the aggregate results to the campus community. This data is very important to showcase the ROI on a Golden Knight education and the value of your Clarkson degree.

The report shares employment rates, provides information on average salary ranges, the top employers/organizations, graduate programs, and geographic locations for recent graduates. The information is collected at graduation points (August, December & May) and that data makes up a class year cohort for data.

The survey is administered through Handshake (is quick and easy to take) and only those graduating have access to take it. The survey launches about 6 weeks prior to each graduation period and closes 6 months after their specific graduation date.

How you can help?

Encouraging graduating seniors to take this survey though Handshake is extremely important to allow our office and campus to collect the most accurate data to share with our faculty, staff, and potential Golden Knights! They will receive a notification email to take the survey when it opens and a reminder each month leading up to the 6 month cut off point.


Sponsored by the Career Center and SSS there will be two sections offered, Tuesday 3-4:15pm or Thursday 1-2:15pm.
