Visa Update / Challenges / Arrival

Visa update - while the student visa application process has improved from the past couple of months, it remains a challenge in some countries to be able to secure a student visa appointment. In addition, some US Consulates are not offering expedited/emergency appointments to students due to the current backlogs.

Our office has stopped processing I-20 documents for the Spring 2022 semester. We will continue to be available on a case by case basis. Please note that if you choose to request documents for a student, we cannot guarantee that the student will be able to complete all the visa application formalities and arrive on time for the start of the Spring 2022 semester.

The International Center will be monitoring the IC email account for arrival / visa challenges during the Winter break and we will respond at the earliest convenience.
