International Visitors: The Process

The International Center is here to assist departments and faculty sponsors with hiring or hosting international faculty, staff and scholars under the J Exchange Visitor Program. This includes assistance with immigration document preparation, arrival guide for J Scholars and general scholar advising on J visa status.

Clarkson can issue documents under the following categories:

- J Professor / Research Scholar: Individual whose primary duties are teaching or research. These categories co-mingle. Length of stay is 3-weeks to 5-years
- J1 Short-Term Scholar: A professor, research scholar or person with similar education or accomplishments coming to the US on a short-term visit for the purpose of lecturing, observing, training or demonstrating special skills. Length of stay is up to 6-months.
- J Student Intern: Student pursuing a degree outside the US where the internship is fulfilling the
 education objective for his/her degree at home institution. Special conditions do apply. Length of
 stay is 3-weeks to 1-year.

Please visit the International Center intranet to view the 'Steps to host a J-1 Scholar'.

Important Note: Please allow at least 2 - 3 months processing prior to the start of the J program. This allows enough time for International Center staff to review and process the visa paperwork, visa processing - and - travel to Clarkson University.

Embassy / Visa Updates for International Recruitment

Director's Note: As the world rebounds from travel restrictions due to COVID, the world's focus has shifted this week to a new reality with Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Visa wait times at US embassies in many countries have extended considerably, the International Center will continue to monitor these situations closely as we move forward with fall recruitment.

UPDATES FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

As the world tries to regain some semblance of normalcy the US Consulates and Embassies around the world are still trying to get caught up with all the backlogs that the Covid-19 restrictions have caused to the visa application process. We would like to continue updating you with 3 additional countries and going forward will focus on countries where are students are expected from.

CAMEROON

The US Consulate is still operating under reduced capacity.

Visa appointments availability in Cameroon is still limited, they are still dealing with backlogs from previous years.

When students pay their visa fee, they acknowledge that it may take several months to schedule an interview appointment.

Expedited appointments are available for students. Students should follow the instructions from the US Consulate website on how to request one.

Third country applicants are highly discouraged. Priority will be given to nationals/citizens and lawful residents.

HONG KONG

Student visa appointment wait time in the US Consulate in Hong Kong is approximately 78 calendar days. Visa processing time is about 3 working days, however, visa processing time may vary depending on individual circumstances and other special requirements.

Expedited appointments are available for students. Students should follow the instructions from the US Consulate website on how to request one. Evidence of SEVIS fee payment is required to request an expedited visa appointment.

PAKISTAN

The US Consulates in Islamabad and Karachi are still operating under very reduced capacity. Expedited appointments are available for students. Students should follow the instructions from the US Consulate website on how to request one.


