


Faculty Workshop: Creating Inclusive Job Ads



Recruiting a diverse academic workforce is an important goal of higher education institutions. Yet, the process many search committees use to recruit and evaluate candidates can be rife with imperfect or biased thinking. This 90-minute interactive workshop draws from the literature and practical experience with faculty search committees to tackle one step in the hiring process: writing the job advertisement. Participants will learn how and why the language used in job ads serve as a critical "nudge" in recruitment and develop strategies for creating equity-minded job ads.
